Teaser	Do you need a residence permit to look for a training place in order to complete qualified vocational training? You can obtain this under certain conditions.
Volltext	<p>You can obtain a residence permit for the purpose of looking for a training place if you would like to complete qualified vocational training in Germany but have not yet found a training place. Qualified vocational training is defined as vocational training in a state-recognized or comparable regulated occupation that lasts at least 2 years.</p> <p>You should be under the age of 35 and must be able to support yourself and pay your health insurance without claiming public benefits.</p> <p>You can take up employment of up to 20 hours per week during your stay. Trial employment is possible for up to two weeks.</p> <p>You will receive a residence permit if you:</p>

It can be issued for a maximum of 9 months.</p> <p>If you have not yet reached the age of 18, you will need the consent of your legal guardians for your stay to apply for a university place.</p>

training in Germany but have not yet found a training position can obtain a residence permit to look for training

- they must: have sufficient German language skills at level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), prove that they are able to support themselves and have a school-leaving certificate that entitles them to enter higher education or have a degree from a German school abroad
- the residence permit is a temporary residence permit. It is issued for a maximum of 9 months, extension is excluded
- the residence permit entitles the holder to work up to 20 hours per week and for trial employment of up to two weeks in total
- A fee is charged for the issue of the residence permit. The time and form of payment vary depending on the authority
