Teaser	You can take advantage of health examinations for your children. Thus, the general state of health and age-appropriate development of a child is regularly examined by a doctor. Possible problems or abnormalities can be detected and treated at an early stage.
Volltext	<p>The statutory health insurance funds cover the costs of medical screening examinations for insured children and adolescents, which are also known as J-examinations. Children and adolescents up to the age of 18 can take advantage of the examinations. They serve the early detection of diseases that endanger their physical, mental or psycho-social development.</p> <p>Details of the content, type and scope of the examinations are regulated by the Federal Joint Committee in the Guideline for Youth Health Examination (J1).</p>
Erforderliche Unterlagen	For the examinations, you will need your child's electronic health card.
Voraussetzungen	<p>In principle, insured children and adolescents are entitled to early detection examinations until they reach the age of 18. However, the following examination periods must be observed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • J1 13-14 years
Kosten	There are no co-payments for health examinations of children and adolescents. Numerous health insurance companies also offer another preventive examination, the J2, as a voluntary service between the ages of 16
