|                          | As a homeless foreigner, you are entitled to<br>naturalisation if you have been legally resident in<br>Germany for at least 7 years and have not been<br>convicted of a criminal offence. This does not apply to<br>sentences of a fine or a juvenile sentence or<br>imprisonment of up to one year, the execution of<br>which has been suspended.<br>The requirements to be fulfilled by you are less<br>extensive compared to the other naturalisation<br>requirements. And the applicable fee is lower.   |
|                          | In addition, your spouse and your minor children can<br>also be naturalised, even if they have not lived in<br>Germany for as long as you have.<br>Naturalisation becomes effective upon delivery of the   |
|                          | certificate of naturalisation. The competent authority is the nationality authority of your place of residence.  |

## Sachverhalt

Law on 30.06.1950, or

• They descend from homeless foreigners and resided in the Federal Republic of Germany on 01.01.1991.

• You must apply for naturalisation

• You must

• have been born at least on 01.01.1991.

• You have been legally and habitually resident in Germany for 7 years.

• Your spouse and minor children can be naturalised together with you even if they have not yet been legally and habitually resident in Germany for 7 years.

• They were not sentenced to imprisonment without probation or to a suspended sentence of more than one year.

• You will not be investigated on suspicion of a criminal offence.

• If it does, the naturalisation procedure remains suspended until the criminal proceedings have been concluded.

• You must also meet the other naturalisation requirements, i.e.

• Your identity and nationality(s) have been clarified

· You are capable of acting or legally represented

• You hold a residence permit or a permanent right of residence which is in principle intended for permanent residence

• You are able to support yourself and that of your dependent family members without receiving certain public benefits

• You have sufficient knowledge of the German language (level B1)

• You have knowledge of the legal and social system and living conditions in Germany

• You give up your foreign citizenship or lose it

• Their classification into the German living conditions is guaranteed; this means in particular that you are not married to several spouses at the same time

• They are committed to the free democratic basic order of the Basic Law; that is, you do not support or have supported anti-constitutional or extremist activities unless you have credibly turned away from previous persecution or support

• • They do not prosecute or support anti-constitutional or extremist activities and have not done so in the past.

| Verfahrensablauf                | <ul> <li>You can submit your application for naturalisation in writing to the competent authority:</li> <li>Fill out the application and submit it by post with the required documents.</li> <li>On receipt of your application, the competent body will examine the conditions and take a decision.</li> <li>If you meet the requirements, you will personally receive a naturalisation certificate. Only then is naturalisation effective.</li> </ul>   |
