Teaser	Tolerated foreigners can obtain a residence permit to carry out employment if they meet certain conditions for this.
Volltext	As a tolerated foreign person, you can obtain a residence permit to work if you have completed qualified vocational training or university studies in Germany. Qualified vocational training exists if you have completed vocational training in a state-recognised or similarly regulated training occupation.The duration of the training must have been at least two years.
	If you have obtained your university degree abroad, you can obtain a residence permit if your foreign degree has been legally recognised in Germany or is comparable to a German university degree. The Central Office for Foreign Education is responsible for the recognition of foreign university degrees in Germany (see under "Further information"). In addition, it is required that you have been employed for two years without interruption with your foreign university degree. Employment is appropriate if it usually requires an academic degree and the knowledge acquired through higher education is needed, at least in part or indirectly. Shorter interruptions of employment, which should normally not exceed a total duration of three months, are harmless.

You can also obtain a residence permit if you have

	obtained your professional qualification abroad, have been engaged in qualified employment without interruption for three years and have not applied for public funds (with the exception of benefits to cover the necessary costs of accommodation and heating) within the last year before applying for the residence permit for your livelihood and that of your family members or other household members. were instructed. Qualified employment exists when it is usually carried out by persons with skills, knowledge and abilities acquired in qualified vocational training or academic training. Shorter interruptions (up to three months) are usually harmless, The residence permit is issued for a limited period of time for the duration of the employment. Holders of the training toleration are granted a residence permit for two years if they wish to pursue employment equivalent to that acquired in vocational training.

Voraussetzungen	 You have a recognized and valid passport or passport replacement. There is no interest in expulsion against you.

	 Your stay does not endanger or adversely affect the interests of the Federal Republic of Germany. You have in the Federal territory completed qualified vocational training in a state-recognised or similarly regulated training occupation or university studies, or with a recognised foreign university degree or a foreign university degree comparable to a German university degree, employment appropriate to their degree for at least two consecutive years, or has been in unskilled employment without interruption for at least three years and has not been dependent on public funds within the last year, with the exception of benefits to cover the necessary costs of accommodation and heating. You have sufficient knowledge of German (B1). You can submit a specific job offer or a contract. The "Declaration on employment relationship" serves as proof of the concrete job offer. You have sufficient living space for yourself and your family. The Federal Employment Agency has agreed to the exercise of employment. You can secure your livelihood and health insurance coverage from your own resources without using public services.

	Under certain conditions, a fee reduction or fee exemption may be considered. Hints:
	 Additional fees may apply for the issuance of the residence permit in the form of the electronic residence permit, which can also be used as electronic proof of identity. The timing and form of charging and payment vary depending on the authority.
Verfahrensablauf	The procedure is as follows:
	• Depending on the foreigners' registration office and concerns, it may be possible to apply via the Internet. Find out whether your immigration office offers the

	 electronic application for a residence permit. If the application is only possible in person, make an appointment with the Foreigners' Registration Office. During the appointment, your application will be accepted and your proofs will be checked (bring them with you to the appointment). Your fingerprints will be taken for the production of an electronic residence permit (eATCard). In the event of an electronic application, the Foreigners' Registration Office will contact you after receipt of your online application in order to make an appointment at the Foreigners' Registration Office if necessary. During the appointment, your proofs will be checked (bring them to the appointment) and your fingerprints will be taken for the production of the electronic residence permit (eAT card). If your application is granted, the Foreigners' Registration Office will arrange for the eATKarte to be produced. After about six to eight weeks, you can pick up the eAT Card at the Foreigners' Registration Office.

Rechtsbehelf	An appeal against a decision of the Foreigners' Registration Office may be lodged with the authority specified in the decision within one month of notification of the decision. The objection can be filed in writing, in electronic form and for record. If the objection is not complied with by the Foreigners' Registration Office, an action may be brought before the court named in the notice of opposition.
Kurztext	 Residence permit for the purpose of gainful employment Issued to qualified tolerated persons for the purpose of employment; Tolerated foreigners living in Germany have completed qualified vocational training in a state-recognised or similarly regulated training occupation or a university degree, or have been employed continuously for two years with a recognised or comparable foreign university degree or a German university degree that was appropriate to their degree, or have been in unskilled employment without interruption for three years and have not been dependent on public funds within the last year, with the exception of benefits to cover the necessary costs of accommodation and heating Can obtain a residence permit for the purpose of employment. The foreign person must have at least sufficient knowledge of the German language (B1). The foreign person must prove sufficient living space. The Federal Employment Agency must agree to the exercise of employment. The residence permit is issued for a limited period of time for the duration of the employment. Holders of the training toleration must be granted a residence permit for two years.

	 Depending on the immigration office and concerns, the application is possible via the Internet or in person. There is a fee for issuing the residence permit. The timing and form of payment vary depending on the authority.
