Teaser	You can take advantage of health check-ups for your children. Thus, the general state of health and age-appropriate development of a child is regularly examined by a doctor. Possible problems or abnormalities can be detected and treated at an early stage.
Volltext	The statutory health insurance funds cover the costs of medical early detection examinations for insured children and adolescents, which are also known as U-examinations and J-examinations. Children and adolescents up to the age of 18 can take advantage of the examinations. They are used for the early detection of diseases that endanger their physical, mental or psycho-social development. Up to the age of six, this also includes early detection examinations for dental, oral and jaw diseases, e.B the determination of the risk of caries and advice on nutrition and oral hygiene. The Federal Joint Committee regulates more detailed information on the content, type and scope of the examinations in the Guideline for the Early Detection of Diseases in Children (U1 to U9) of the Guideline on Adolescent Health Examination (J1).
Erforderliche Unterlagen	For the examinations, you will need your child's electronic health card and the children's examination booklet ("Yellow Booklet"), which you will receive immediately after birth.
Voraussetzungen	Insured children and adolescents are entitled to early detection examinations up to the age of 18. However, the following examination periods must be observed: • U1 Immediately after birth
