Teaser	The period of validity of driving licences for categories C, C1, CE, C1E, D, D1, DE and D1E is extended by five years at the holder's request if the licence holder proves his or her suitability and that he or she meets the vision requirements. Likewise, there must be no facts that justify the assumption that one of the other requirements for the issue of a driving licence is missing. These requirements also apply if you apply for a new driving licence after your previous one has expired.
Volltext	Driving licences for categories C, CE, C1, C1E (HGV) and D1, D1E, D and DE (bus) are issued for a maximum of five years. The period of validity of driving licences for categories C, C1, CE, C1E, D, D1, DE and D1E is extended by five years at the holder's request if the licence holder proves his or her suitability and that he or she meets the vision requirements. Likewise, there must be no facts that justify the assumption that one of the other requirements for the issue of a driving licence is missing. These requirements also apply if you apply for a new driving licence after your previous one has expired. Note:
