Volltext	<p>You can apply online to the State Law Examination Office for admission to the compulsory state examination in the Free State of Saxony.</p> <p>After completing your law degree, you must take the First Law Examination. This is divided into a state compulsory subject examination and a university specialisation examination. Students at the Faculty of Law at Leipzig University can use this application to apply for admission to the compulsory state examination, which is organised by the Saxony State Justice Examination Office. Examination registration takes place exclusively via the electronic form.</p>

You will be asked for this again at the end of the application.</li> <li>• You can upload all the necessary documents in the online application or send them by post to the Saxony Judicial Examination Office.</li> <li>• Once all data fields have been completed, you finalise the application and the data is sent to the relevant office.</li> </ul> <p>Once your complete application and the required supporting documents have been submitted, the State Judicial Examination Office will issue a letter of admission.</p> <p>Instructions for using the online application: Please only use browsers that are common for the Windows operating system (e.g. Chrome, Firefox, Edge) to submit your application.
