To obtain the eHBA, you must first enroll in the electronic health professional registry (eGBR). You then apply for the eHBA from a trusted service provider (VDA). VDAs charge an annual fee, which may vary from VDA to VDA.

- Completed application form
- Scan or photo of your professional license (professional license certificate)
- If applicable, proof of name change (for example, marriage certificate)

Voraussetzungen

- You must present a professional license.
- You must pay the administrative fee.

You can apply for an electronic health professional card (eHBA) online:

- Go to the specialised portal of the electronic Health Professions Register (eGBR) and complete the online application
- Entry in the eGBR costs a one-off administration fee.
- Once your application has been received, your professional authorisation will be checked.
- Once the check has been completed, you will receive an e-mail with the results of the check and your process number.
- Use the process number to order your eHBA as a chip card from a trust service provider (VDA) of your choice for a fee.
