certificate'. This certificate serves as evidence that you regularly provide this service in Germany on a legitimate basis. If you or your company is a member of a chamber (e.g., the Chamber of Skilled Trades and Crafts, or in German), this is the responsible chamber in your case. If not, please contact your Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

To prove that you provide your services permanently and lawfully, you must provide information on the specific activities you carry out and their duration. Apart from a description of your business activities, you must indicate whether you work on a self-employed basis, as the manager of a company or the manager of a company branch, in a management position or as an employee.

Erforderliche Unterlagen

- Copy of your identity card
- Evidence of nature and duration of specific professional experience
- Evidence of professional training and education (certificates, diplomas)
- Additionall, as a: Self-employed businessperson: trade registration () Manager of a company or of a company branch office – as evidence: commercial register entry Employees in managerial positions: employment contract, employer references Non-management employees: employment contract, employer references

Voraussetzungen

- Practice of the profession in the last two years
- Information on the nature of professional activities and evidence thereof

Kosten

Fees apply. Your local Chamber of Commerce and Industry or Chamber of Skilled Trades and Crafts will provide the details.

Verfahrensablauf

You can apply to the competent authority in writing for your EU certificate.

- You must submit the required supporting documents along with your application.
- Once the competent authority has reviewed your documents, the EU certificate will be issued and sent to you by post along with an invoice
