Teaser	If you export plants, plant products or other objects to countries outside the EU, they must not contain any harmful organisms. As proof of this, you must apply for a phytosanitary certificate or a pre-export certificate or re-export certificate.
Volltext	Plant diseases and pests can be introduced during international trade in plants, plant products or other objects. Such harmful organisms run the risk of spreading uncontrollably in a new environment and causing major economic damage. For these reasons, international trade in this area is subject to strict phytosanitary monitoring. Therefore, if you wish to export plants, plant products and other objects to countries outside the European Union (EU), you will require the following prior to export  • a phytosanitary certificate (PGZ) • and, if applicable, one or more pre-export certificates (VAZ) • or, in the case of import from a third country with subsequent export to a third country, a phytosanitary certificate for re-export.  After prior inspection, compliance with the phytosanitary import requirements of the respective country of destination is confirmed with the PGZ / VAZ.

	You must apply for one or more VACs at the respective place of origin if
	<ul> <li>your consignment consists of partial consignments originating from areas of different phytosanitary services of the federal states / EU member states or</li> <li>the origin of your consignment is not in the same area of responsibility of a phytosanitary service as the place where the necessary treatment of the consignment must be carried out.</li> </ul>
	The VAZ serve as the basis for the PGZ, which you can apply for from the responsible official phytosanitary service in the federal state. If the inspection is successful, both of these documents will confirm that the phytosanitary requirements of the respective importing country have been met.
_	You will need the following information for the online form:
	<ul> <li>Addresses of the applicant the exporter or the exporter the postal and invoice address of the postal and invoice addressee</li> <li>Name of the consignee and the importing country</li> <li>Place of origin</li> <li>Means of transportation</li> <li>Registration number of the exporter</li> <li>Inspection location, date and contact person on site</li> <li>Description of goods, botanical name and quantities</li> <li>Any treatments carried out, including protocols</li> <li>Import permit of the importing country, if applicable</li> <li>Test reports of laboratory tests, if applicable</li> </ul>

	You apply for the required phytosanitary certificate or pre-export certificate or re-export certificate and the necessary inspections. The official phytosanitary service of the federal state checks the application and informs you of the next steps.

Kurztext	<ul> <li>Issuing phytosanitary certificates for export to third countries</li> <li>Companies wishing to export plants, plant products or other objects to countries outside the European Union (EU) require - if the phytosanitary import regulations of the destination country provide for this - a phytosanitary certificate (PGZ) and, if applicable, one or more pre-export certificates (VAZ)</li> <li>International trade in plants, plant products or other objects is subject to strict controls</li> <li>there is a risk of harmful organisms spreading uncontrollably in a new environment and causing major economic damage</li> <li>after prior inspection, the PGZ / VAZ confirms compliance with the import requirements of the respective receiving country</li> <li>the PGZ for re-export certifies the re-export and is accompanied by the PGZ from the country of origin</li> <li>in the case of partial consignments originating from areas of different phytosanitary services of the federal states / EU member states, one or more VACs must be applied for at the respective place of origin</li> <li>the same applies if the origin of the consignment is not in the same area of responsibility of a phytosanitary service as the place where the necessary treatment of the consignment must be carried out</li> <li>VAZ serves as the basis for the PGZ and must be applied for by the exporter</li> <li>VAZ and PGZ confirm that the phytosanitary requirements of the respective importing country are met</li> <li>Responsible: responsible official phytosanitary service of the federal state</li> </ul>
