Teaser	In many countries outside the European Union (EU), you need a passport to enter the country. If you have German citizenship, you can apply for a German passport. Current information on the delivery time can be found in the detailed service description.
Volltext	Current information (as of 16.07.2024) Due to the currently very long waiting times for a passport, it is strongly recommended that you apply for the required passports at the time of planning your trip, but no later than 2½ months before the start of your trip. If you need a passport at short notice, you can apply for a passport using the express procedure (see the link below: "Applying for a passport using the express procedure"). If the time for issuing an express passport (production time max. 72 hours) is also too short and it can no longer be issued in time for the first use, you can apply for a passport as a temporary passport. The German passport allows you to enter over 160 countries worldwide for tourism purposes without a visa. You need a passport above all if you wish to travel to countries outside the European Union (EU). If you have German citizenship, you can apply for a German passport.

Passport for children

Passports can be issued for children from the age of 0. If you are planning to travel to other EU countries with your child, you should apply for a biometric passport instead of a children's passport. This is because some countries, such as the USA, do not recognize children's passports or ID cards for visa-free tourist entry.

Application

You must be present in person when applying for a passport so that your identity can be verified. If you wish to apply for a passport for your child, the child must be present in person.

If you cannot be present in person, only a temporary passport can be issued. The passport must then be collected in person.

You can apply for a passport at the Citizens' Office at your place of residence. If you have more than one place of residence, the citizens' office at your main place of residence is responsible.

It is also possible to apply at another passport authority if you can provide an important reason. Due to the increased administrative effort of the passport authority without jurisdiction - it must obtain an authorization from the locally competent passport authority - a surcharge must be paid in addition to the fee for the passport you have applied for.

If you live abroad, the German representation abroad is responsible for passport applications. If you have

lost your passport abroad due to loss or theft, apply for a new passport at the German representation abroad.

If the regular processing time is too long for you, you have the option of applying for your passport using the express procedure. If you need the travel document at very short notice and cannot wait for delivery of the passport using the express procedure, you will be issued with a temporary passport.

Erforderliche Unterlagen

- Proof of identity (passport, identity card, child's identity card, child's passport),
- biometric photograph,
- · your previous passport, if applicable,
- your birth certificate, if applicable,
- when applying for a child: ID of the custodian present Declaration of consent and a copy of the ID of the non-present legal guardian or proof of custody if there is only one legal guardian.
- Further documents, such as civil status certificates, may be required when the certificate is issued for the first time or when moving to a municipality.

Voraussetzungen

- You have German citizenship.
- There must be no grounds for refusing a passport, such as the assumption that you wish to avoid prosecution, execution of a sentence or a statutory maintenance obligation by leaving the country.

Verfahrensablauf

- You must apply for a passport in person.
- As a rule, you make an appointment for this at your local citizens' office.
- Bring all the necessary documents with you to the appointment.
- The application will be completed on the spot with the clerk. All you have to do is sign it.
- If the person for whom the passport is being applied for has reached the age of 6, the submission of fingerprints for storage in the document is required by law (usually a flat print of the left and right index finger). Once the passport has been produced, it is sent by the passport manufacturer to the citizens' registration office where the application was made.
- You will receive instructions from your Citizens' Registration Office as to when you can collect your passport.

	• You can then collect your passport from your local Citizens' Registration Office. You can authorize another person of legal age in writing to collect your passport.
