Teaser	If you or your child were born abroad, it may be useful to have your birth recorded in the German birth register.
Volltext	<p>If you or your child were born abroad, you can apply for subsequent certification of the birth. There is no legal obligation for subsequent certification. A proper foreign birth certificate (if necessary with translation, legalization or apostille) also proves the fact of birth. A subsequent certification can be useful if the name or the descent relations are to be proven bindingly in Germany. Furthermore, the registry office I in Berlin can issue you new certificates (also multilingual) at any time after the certification.</p> <p>If the German parent was born abroad after 31.12.1999, the child acquires German citizenship with habitual residence abroad only if the certification of the birth in the German birth register is applied for within one year after the birth of the child, unless the child would otherwise become stateless.</p>

This depends on the foreign certificate system and can only be assessed after the application has been examined.</p>
Voraussetzungen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The child has acquired German citizenship by descent from a German parent or by naturalization. • The persons entitled to apply are the person to be registered himself/herself their parents their children the spouse or civil partner
Kosten	<p>The subsequent certification of a birth abroad is subject to a fee. In Thuringia, the fee for subsequent certification is € 90.00. A birth certificate created from the birth register costs € 10.00.</p>
Verfahrensablauf	<p>In principle, the application can be submitted via the German diplomatic mission abroad in case of residence abroad.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All documents and IDs must be presented there in the original. • If necessary, certified copies can be made at the mission abroad, for which further fees will be charged. • The mission abroad can usually also determine whether a name declaration is required. In this case, a corresponding declaration can be recorded on the spot.

Frist	<p>None, but in certain cases there are consequences under nationality law if the subsequent certification of the birth is not applied for within one year.</p>
