| Volltext                         | A death that occurred abroad can also be certified in a<br>German death register at your request. The so-called<br>subsequent certification also applies to deaths on<br>foreign sea-going vessels.  |
|                                  | Deaths on foreign sea-going vessels are deaths abroad<br>with the special feature that the place of death is a<br>foreign sea-going vessel.  |
|                                  | With the subsequent notarization, an entry is made in a German death register in addition to the notarization abroad.  |
|                                  | You can apply for the subsequent notarization at the competent German registry office.   |
| Erforderliche Unterlagen         | In addition to the information to be included in the death entry, you must submit the necessary certificates or other documents.   |

|                                  | <ul> <li>Your identity card/passport as the applicant</li> <li>Foreign death certificate of the deceased person (if necessary with translation and certification by the competent foreign authority (apostille) or legalization</li> </ul> |

| Voraussetzungen  | <ul> <li>The death occurred on a foreign sea-going vessel</li> <li>The death occurred during a sea voyage outside the sea-going vessel - but not on land or in an inland port - and the deceased person was picked up by a foreign sea-going vessel</li> <li>The deceased person was a German national at the time of death or had the status of a stateless person, a homeless foreigner or a foreign refugee within the meaning of the Convention relating to the Status of Refugees having their habitual residence in Germany.</li> <li>Entitled to apply are the parents of the deceased person the children of the deceased person swho can assert a legal interest in the notarization vis-à-vis the registry office</li> </ul> |

| Verfahrensablauf | <ul> <li>The application for subsequent certification of a death<br/>on a foreign sea-going vessel must be submitted to the<br/>competent German registry office.</li> <li>Contact the relevant German registry office in writing,<br/>by telephone or in person, describe your request and<br/>ask for the documents you need to submit.</li> </ul>   |

| Kurztext                        | <ul> <li>Deaths abroad Notarization of deaths on sea-going vessels</li> <li>Subsequent certification of a death on a foreign sea-going vessel in a German death register.</li> <li>The application for subsequent notarization can be submitted to the competent German registry office under certain conditions.</li> <li>Fees are charged by the registry office.</li> <li>The subsequent certification is a prerequisite for the issue of a German death certificate.</li> <li>Responsible: The registry office in whose area the deceased had their (last) place of residence or habitual abode in Germany is responsible for the application. If the deceased person did not have a place of residence or habitual abode in Germany, the registry office in whose area the applicant has or last had their place of residence or habitual abode is responsible. If none of the above alternatives apply, the application can be submitted to Registry Office I in Berlin.</li> </ul> |
