Teaser	If you have German citizenship, you can apply for an identity card.
Volltext	Germans within the meaning of the Basic Law are obliged to have a valid identity card as soon as they reach the age of 16 and are subject to the general registration obligation or, without being subject to it,

reside predominantly in Germany. Any person of any age who is a German citizen can apply for an ID card.

The identity card becomes invalid before the expiry of its validity period if

- entries become incorrect or
- the photograph is no longer clearly suitable for identification purposes. This can be the case in particular with ID cards for infants or very young children.

There is one exception: a change of address does not invalidate the card.

The period of validity depends on your age at the time of application:

- Application under the age of 24: ID card is valid for 6 years.
- Application from the age of 24: Identity card is valid for 10 years.

A temporary ID card is valid for a maximum of 3 months.

You can submit the application to your identity card authority at your main place of residence, which is usually the Citizens' Registration Office. Applications can be made to any other identity card authority if an important reason is presented. This will incur a surcharge for lack of jurisdiction, which means that the cost of your new ID card will be higher.

Since 01.09.2021, a transparent Braille sticker with the inscription "ad" (identity document) can be affixed to the ID card, the eID card or the electronic residence permit on the back of the ID card at the request of the document holder. The Braille sticker is intended to make it easier to distinguish the ID card, eID card or electronic residence permit from other cards in cheque card format, for example in a wallet.

The competent identity card authority can exempt persons from the obligation to have an identity card,

- 1. for whom a guardian has been appointed by more than a temporary order or who are incapable of acting or consenting and are represented by an authorized representative with a publicly certified power of attorney,
- who are likely to be permanently accommodated in a hospital, nursing home or similar institution, or
   who are unable to move about in public on their own due to a permanent disability.

An ID card can also be issued on request if a person is under the age of 16 or if they are German within the meaning of the Basic Law but are not subject to the registration requirement because they do not have a home in Germany (e.g. Germans living abroad).

## Erforderliche Unterlagen

- Identity card, valid passport or children's passport or birth certificate
- for children under the age of 16: Declaration of consent from the legal guardian if there is only one parent or legal guardian, additional proof of custody
- biometric passport photo: From May 1, 2025, only digitally available biometric photos will be used for new official documents. The photographs will either be taken at the authorities or by photographers. This means that citizens will no longer be able to bring their own photographs with them.

- German within the meaning of Article 116 Paragraph 1 of the Basic Law
- Submission of a formal application to the relevant municipality by the applicant (from the age of 16) or legal representative (for example, in the case of joint custody by both parents, if they are not only

	temporarily separated, usually by the parent with whom the child usually resides) or guardian  • Representation by authorized representatives not permitted  • The identity card applicant (i.e. also the child or young person under the age of 16) must always appear in person at the identity card authority to verify their identity.  • For applications outside your main place of residence: You must be able to provide an important reason why you are not applying for the ID card at the ID card authority at your main place of residence.

Verfahrensablauf	<ul> <li>You can make an appointment online, by e-mail or by telephone at many citizens' offices. You can find out which options your citizens' office offers on their website, for example.</li> <li>When you apply for your ID card, your citizens' office will tell you when you can collect it.</li> <li>Your ID card is produced centrally by the Bundesdruckerei in Berlin.</li> <li>You can arrange a collection date online, by e-mail or by telephone at many citizens' offices. Find out about the options offered by your local citizens' office, for example on their website.</li> </ul>
Bearbeitungsdauer	It usually takes at least 2 to 3 weeks from the date of application before you can collect your ID card from the Citizens' Registration Office.
Frist	You must apply for an identity card at the latest when you turn 16. Exception: You have a valid passport document, i.e. passport, children's passport or temporary passport. If you are over 16 years old, you

	must apply for a new ID card at the latest when your old ID card expires. Exception: You have a valid passport document.

Hinweise	You can apply for an ID card at the citizens' office at your place of residence, or at your main place of residence if you have more than one residence. You can also apply for your ID card at any other citizens' office. However, you need an important reason for doing so. If you contact your chosen Citizens' Registration Office in advance, you can find out whether and to what extent the Citizens' Registration Office will accept your reason.
