Zuständige Stelle	The decision on the retention application is made by the Thuringian State Administration Office if the applicant is domiciled or permanently resides in the Free State of Thuringia. In the case of permanent residence abroad, the Federal Office of Administration decides on the application for retention.
Formulare	The application should be made in writing. An official form is not prescribed. To facilitate the application, the citizenship authorities provide forms. A personal visit is required. It is advisable to make an appointment in advance.
