Ansprechpunkt	You can submit the name declaration to the Federal Office of Administration in the distribution procedure or to the registry office. If it is a declaration in

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connection with the birth of a child, the registry office that keeps the register of births is responsible.

If you wish to make a declaration of a joint married name, the registry office that keeps the marriage register is responsible. In all other cases, the registry office at your place of residence is responsible.
