| Volltext                       | If you have become an heir, in principle you take over all the assets and liabilities (debts) of the deceased. However, you are not obliged to accept an inheritance, but can also refuse it. This applies regardless of whether you inherit on the basis of intestate succession, a will or an inheritance contract. Find out what assets and debts are available.
