|                                  | <ul> <li>the attendance of a study-preparatory language<br/>course, if an admission to study has already been<br/>granted and the admission is bound to the attendance<br/>of a study-preparatory course and</li> <li>the attendance of a Studienkolleg or a comparable<br/>institution, if a place is certainly available.</li> </ul> |
|                                  | The residence permit for the purpose of studying is a temporary residence title.   |
|                                  | With your residence permit for the purpose of studies,<br>you are allowed to pursue employment for up to 120<br>days or 240 half days per year or a part-time student<br>job. You are not allowed to work during study<br>preparation measures in the first year, except during<br>the vacation period.                                |

| Voraussetzungen | <ul> <li>You have a recognized and valid identity document<br/>(for example, passport or passport substitute) and - if<br/>this was required for entry - an appropriate visa.</li> <li>You have an admission to a state-recognized<br/>university or a recognized educational institution in<br/>Germany.</li> <li>It is a full-time study program.</li> <li>Your livelihood is secured for the duration of your<br/>studies.</li> <li>Depending on the study requirements of your degree<br/>program, you may have to prove to the Aliens'<br/>Registration Office that you have the language skills<br/>required for your studies (usually at least level B2). No<br/>proof of language skills is required if these have<br/>already been tested by the receiving university as part<br/>of the admission decision or if they are to be acquired<br/>as part of a language course preparing for studies.</li> <li>There is no expulsion interest against you.</li> <li>Your stay does not endanger or impair the interests<br/>of the Federal Republic of Germany.</li> </ul> |

| Verfahrensablauf                | <ul> <li>The residence permit must be applied for before your visa or visa-free residence period or your current residence permit expires.</li> <li>Find out whether your Aliens' Registration Office allows you to apply online or has a special application form.</li> <li>If the application can only be submitted in person, make an appointment at the Foreigners' Registration Office. In the case of online application, the Aliens' Registration Office will contact you after receiving your application to schedule an appointment.</li> <li>During the appointment, your identity and documents will be checked (please bring your documents to the appointment, if possible in original).</li> <li>If your application is granted, your fingerprints will be taken for the production of the residence permit in the form of the electronic residence permit (eAT card). You will also be required to sign a document.</li> <li>The Foreigners' Registration Office will receive information and can pick up the eAT card at the responsible office. As a rule, you must pick up the card in person.</li> <li>If your application is rejected, you will receive a rejection notice.</li> </ul> |
| Bearbeitungsdauer               | Duration (at fixed time): Approx. 8 Note for further<br>information on the processing time: The processing<br>time for the issuance of a residence permit can vary<br>depending on the workload of the Foreigners'<br>Registration Office. It takes about 4 to 6 weeks for the<br>Bundesdruckerei to produce the electronic residence<br>permit.   |
| Frist                           | • The residence permit should be applied for no later<br>than eight weeks before the expiry of your visa or<br>residence permit that is still valid. • Deadline for<br>appeal: 1 month   |

In case of insufficient knowledge of German, it is recommended to appear with a person who can act as a translator.</li> <li>All information provided to the Aliens' Registration Office should be correct and complete to the best of your knowledge and belief, so that the request can be processed without major delays.</li> <li>Incorrect or incomplete information may slow down the process and be detrimental to the individual. In a serious case, incorrect or incomplete information that is not completed or corrected in time vis-à-vis the Aliens Department may result in the revocation of residence rights already granted, a fine, a prison sentence of up to three years, or expulsion from the Federal territory.</li> <li>Due to the complexity of the right of residence, this description is for information purposes only and is not legally binding.</li> </ul> |
| Rechtsbehelf | Negative decisions of the Foreigners' Registration<br>Office may be appealed to the competent<br>administrative court.   |
| Kurztext     | <ul> <li>Residence permit for the purpose of education<br/>Issuance for the purpose of study preparation and<br/>study</li> <li>Foreigners who wish to study in Germany may be<br/>granted a residence permit for the purpose of study if<br/>they have been admitted to a state-recognized<br/>university in Germany.</li> <li>The purpose of residence for the purpose of studying<br/>also includes the completion of a compulsory<br/>internship and study preparation measures such as<br/>attending a study preparation language course - if<br/>already admitted to full-time studies - and attending a<br/>Studienkolleg or a comparable institution if a secure<br/>place is already available.</li> <li>The residence permit is issued for a limited period of<br/>at least one year and usually for a maximum of two</li> </ul>   |

|                   | <ul> <li>years. If the studies last less than two years, it is issued for the duration of the studies. In case of participation in a Union or multilateral program with mobility measures (for example ERASMUS+ program of the European Union) or if an agreement between two or more higher education institutions applies to the foreigner, the residence permit is issued for at least two years, or for the duration of the studies if the studies last less than two years.</li> <li>The residence permit entitles the holder to work up to 120 days or 240 half-days per year and to do part-time student work; this does not apply during the stay for study preparation measures in the first year of the stay, except during the vacation period.</li> <li>Depending on the foreigners authority and the request, the application can be made via the Internet or in person.</li> <li>A fee is charged for the issuance of the residence permit. The time as well as the form of payment varies depending on the authority.</li> <li>Responsible: the authority responsible for the place of residence of the applicant foreigners authority</li> </ul> |
