Teaser	You can obtain a permit to operate an insemination station or embryo collection or production unit if you meet certain recognition requirements.
Volltext	<p>If you wish to operate an insemination station, embryo collection or production unit for cattle, pigs, sheep, goats or equidae, you require a permit in accordance with the Animal Breeding Act.</p> <p>The permit is issued if</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a veterinarian is in charge of the veterinary and technical management of the facility or the performance of the veterinary and technical tasks by a veterinarian who is contractually bound to the insemination station is guaranteed,</li> <li>• the personnel required for proper operation are available,</li> <li>• the facilities required for the collection, treatment, storage and delivery of semen are available and</li> <li>• in the case of an insemination station, the male breeding animals are available.</li> </ul> <p>The permit relates to the respective facility with its operating units and to the respective animal species. It is generally granted for 10 years. It can be reissued.</p>

<b>Erforderliche Unterlagen</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>the name, address and legal form of the operator</li> <li>the addresses of all parts of the establishment and an indication of their function for the collection, treatment, storage and delivery of the semen or oocytes and embryos</li> <li>an indication of the material area of activity</li> </ul>
<b>Voraussetzungen</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The registered office of your facility is located in Germany.</li> <li>They can ensure that the animal health requirements necessary to maintain the health of the livestock are met.</li> <li>They can ensure that a veterinarian is in charge of the veterinary and technical management of the facility or that a contractually bound veterinarian is responsible for meeting the technical veterinary requirements.</li> </ul>
<b>Kosten</b>	<p>Issuing the permit</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>for cattle, pigs and horses: EUR 500.00 - 1,600.00</li> <li>for sheep and goats: EUR 100.00 - 300.00</li> </ul>
<b>Verfahrensablauf</b>	<p>The operator's license must be applied for from the animal breeding authority responsible for the location of the facility.</p> <p>The procedure is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>An informal written application must be submitted with the necessary documents for an operating license.</li> <li>After checking the recognition requirements by means of an on-site inspection, a decision is made to grant the permit.</li> <li>The permit may be issued subject to conditions.</li> </ul>
<b>Bearbeitungsdauer</b>	about 6 to 8 weeks
<b>Frist</b>	The permit should be applied for at least eight weeks before the planned start of operation of the facility or before the previous permit expires.

<b>Kurztext</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Authorization for the purpose of the collection, treatment, storage and delivery of semen or ova and embryos of farm animals.</li> <li>Operators of insemination stations or embryo collection or production units require a permit from the local authority responsible for the location of the facility.</li> <li>The permit is limited to Germany and is generally granted for 10 years; it may be renewed.</li> </ul>
