Teaser	Have you completed further training as a specialist dentist abroad? Then you can apply for recognition as a specialist dentist in Germany under certain conditions.
Volltext	<p>The profession of specialist dentist is regulated in Germany. This means: You need a permit if you want to use the designation "Fachzahnärztin" or "Fachzahnarzt" for your specialization in the federal state you have chosen.</p> <p>With the training as a specialist dentist, you have acquired a medical specialization for your qualification as a dentist abroad. To work as a dentist in Germany, you first need a license to practice medicine or a professional license. In order to be able to work as a specialist dentist in Germany, you must also apply for recognition of your further training as a specialist dentist. This allows you to use the designation "Fachzahnärztin" or "Fachzahnarzt" in your respective specialization.</p> <p>Note: You may only use the designation for your specialization if there is a corresponding further education designation in Germany.</p> <p>Permission will be granted by the competent state dental association after examining your documents and requirements.</p>

	<p>professional experience</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Additional evidence to verify equivalence</li> <li>• Written declaration as to whether you have already submitted an application for recognition to another medical association</li> </ul> <p>If your documents are not in German, you must submit German translations of your documents. The translations must be made by translators who are publicly appointed or authorized.</p>
Voraussetzungen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You must already have a state professional license (approbation) valid in Germany as a dentist or a professional permit.</li> <li>• You must prove the equivalence of your professional qualification as a specialist dentist.</li> </ul>

Verfahrensablauf	<p>Before you submit the application, you must already have a license to practice dentistry or a professional license in Germany.</p> <p>You can apply for recognition of your postgraduate qualification as a specialist dentist at the responsible regional dental association:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First, submit your application and the required documents to the dentists' association of the federal state in which you would like to work.</li> <li>• You may be asked to submit missing documents.</li> <li>• The competent authority checks whether your professional qualification is equivalent. The professional qualification is equivalent if there are no significant differences between your foreign professional qualification and the German professional qualification.</li> <li>• If your qualification as a specialist dentist is recognised, you can work in this profession in Germany. You will receive a notification.</li> </ul> <p>If significant differences are found, the equivalence of your specialist dentist qualification will not be certified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You will receive a reason.</li> <li>• You can take a compensatory measure to prove the lack of knowledge.</li> </ul>

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If you successfully complete the compensatory measure, you will receive recognition. You may then use the designation "Fachzahnärztin" or "Fachzahnarzt" for your specialization.</li> </ul> <p>You can take legal action against the decision of the competent authority within a certain period of time (e.g. file an objection). The decision is then reviewed. Details can be found in the instructions on legal remedies at the end of your decision. It is best to speak to the competent authority first before taking legal action against the decision.</p>

Third countries are all countries that do not belong to the European Union (EU), the European Economic Area (EEA) or Switzerland.</li> <li>• The competent authority checks whether the foreign qualification is equivalent to the German qualification.</li> <li>• Prerequisite: Approval as a dentist or a professional license</li> <li>• Processing time: within 3 months after receipt of the complete documents; The deadline can be extended by one month.</li> <li>• If significant differences are found: a measure can be taken to demonstrate a lack of knowledge.</li> <li>• Responsible: State Dental Associations</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
