Volltext	Vaccinations are one of the most important measures to prevent diseases. Some diseases no longer occur, or only very rarely, because most people have been vaccinated. Before vaccines are approved, their effectiveness and safety must be proven in studies. The independent Standing Vaccination Commission (STIKO) then checks which group of people and when a vaccination should be administered in Germany. Individual advice from your doctor or the competent authority is based on these recommendations.

Vaccinations for professionals: Certain professional groups have a higher risk of infection than other people. On the website of the Green Cross you will find a list of vaccinations that are recommended for various professional groups. Vaccinations during pregnancy: Vaccinations that are important for pregnant people can be found on the Green Cross website. Vaccinations for travelers: Vaccinations that are important for travelers can be found on the "fit for travel" pages. Vaccinations carried out are entered in a yellow vaccination card. You can get the vaccination card from your family doctor.
