Teaser	If your home country does not know and does not issue a marriage certificate, you must be "exempted" from the obligation to present one
Volltext	<p>You would like to get married, but your home country does not have a marriage certificate and does not issue one, you must be "exempted" from the obligation to present one.</p> <p>Only a higher regional court can decide on this. In Hamburg it is the Hanseatic Higher Regional Court. Your registry office will help you with the registration for marriage.</p>
Erforderliche Unterlagen	<p>You must present all the documents that confirm the birth, singleness, previous marriages, if applicable, final divorce and current marital status.</p> <p>The exact documents required depend on the individual case.</p>
Voraussetzungen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You live in Germany</li> <li>• They intend to get married</li> <li>• They (the couple who want to marry) do not both have German citizenship</li> <li>• The home country of the foreign spouse does not have a marriage certificate</li> </ul>
Kosten	There are costs of 50.00 EUR to 300.00 EUR.
Verfahrensablauf	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If, in the course of registering a marriage with foreign participants, you apply for an exemption from the need to provide a certificate of marriage eligibility from your home country, your registry office will help you with this.</li> <li>• The registry office forwards the application to the competent higher regional court. Please contact the registry office at your place of residence.</li> </ul>

Bearbeitungsdauer	The processing time at the Hanseatic Higher Regional Court is usually between 4 and 6 weeks.
Frist	If the Higher Regional Court has granted an "exemption", this applies for 6 months.
