Teaser	The border inspection posts in Bremerhaven, Bremen and Cuxhaven are responsible for the import control of food and feed of animal and non-animal origin from third countries (countries outside the European Union). Once import controls have been carried out, the consignments can be cleared through customs and are then freely tradable in the EU. They are not subject to any further controls.
Volltext	The work of the border inspection post serves to - Protect EU member states from the introduction of animal diseases from abroad - Protect consumers from health risks that may emanate from food - Protect humans and animals from feedstuffs that are hazardous to health

Verfahrensablauf	Registration of third country consignments with GGED P / GGED D , BL (Bill of Lading) as well as a valid health certificate and, if applicable, laboratory results A document check and, depending on the product, a presentation for identity check and goods inspection takes place. The results are recorded in the GGED P / GGED D and a decision is made on import eligibility (import permit, import under certain conditions, rejection)
Bearbeitungsdauer	Release immediately after presentation of the container and successful inspection. In certain cases of further laboratory tests (suspect samples), the result must be awaited. Waiting time up to one week.
Frist	Pre-notification of the consignment one working day before the arrival of the consignment at the port

Hinweise	Special provisions for personal travel: The import of foodstuffs of animal origin from countries outside the EU is largely prohibited. The border inspection posts in Bremen, Bremerhaven and Cuxhafen are not authorized for the clearance of live animals from third countries. There is also no border inspection post at Bremen Airport.
